Beijing Trip

Day 1: Shanghai – Beijing

Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be picked up by your tour guide and go to visit **Tian An Men Square** which is Located at the center of Beijing City, where you can visit Tiananmen Tower, Monument to the People's Heroes, Great Hall of the People, Mao Zedong Memorial Hall. Thousands of people come to the Square every day. It is the must place to visit in Beijing City. Leaving Tian An Men Square, we will head for **Forbidden City**. It was the imperial palace during the Ming and Qing dynasties which is called Gu Gong in Chinese and known as the Palace Museum. Then you'll visit the old Beijing lanes by taking rickshaws.

In the evening, you will go to enjoy famous **Quanjude Peking Roast Duck**.



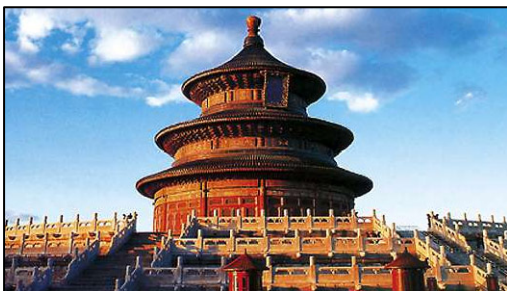
Day 2: Beijing – Great Wall Mutianyu – Beijing



Have breakfast in hotel. Today we will proceed to the **Ming Tombs**, the best preserved Chinese imperial tombs with 500 years of history. It is located at 50 kilometers northwest from Beijing City - the general name given to the mausoleums of 13 emperors of the Ming Dynasty. The mausoleums have been perfectly preserved, as has the necropolis of each of the many emperors. After Ming Tombs, we will visit the symbol of China-**Mutianyu Great Wall**. Located among the orchards and pines in the mountains to the north of Beijing, the Great

Wall of China was constructed and reconstructed at Mu Tian Yu to keep out the nomadic tribes to the north. The Great Wall of China at Mutianyu stands as a monument to both the strength and the weakness of the Chinese Ming Dynasty, and you can learn, touch, and explore the history of China.

Day 3: Beijing



After having breakfast at hotel, you will visit **Temple of Heaven**, one of the largest parks in Beijing. Getting up early, you will see the local people play Taichi, and you will also see some of the most magnificent buildings. In the afternoon, you will go to take a **Hutong tour** which lasts for 3 hours where you will visit typical Chinese quadrangles, a primary school, and many famous old buildings like the bell tower, where you can explore the real life of ordinary people in Beijing.



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Day 4: Beijing – Shanghai



After breakfast at hotel, guide will meet you at hotel main lobby. You will visit **Summer Palace**, one of China's largest and best preserved imperial gardens. The northern part of the Summer Palace is the 60m tall Longevity Hill. Its southern part is a wide expanse of water called Kunming Lake. The whole garden covers 290 hectares, with the lake taking up four-fifths of its total area. You will take **cruise** on the Kunming Lake if the weather is nice. After four days' exploration with wonderful experience in Beijing, you will depart in the afternoon and go back to Shanghai.
